

## PE Kit

<b>Trainers</b>		
Sports trainers only. No high tops or boots.		
		

From after Easter, students will not change for PE, instead coming to school in PE kit (plus their blazer) on the days that they have PE.

This will mean that:

- Students have more time for practical PE
- Students are not required to carry heavy items around the school during the day
- There will not be any concerns about behaviour in changing rooms.

However, we will be raising expectations re PE kit and will be checking this each morning.

- Students must bring your **blazer** on PE days and wear it at line up and when transitioning between lessons like all other days
- Students **must not wear long sleeve tops or leggings or tights under shorts or T shirts.**
- If students want to cover their legs or arms, they need to wear the jogging bottoms or the long sleeve branded top.
- From the 2<sup>nd</sup> week after Easter, if students wear banned items for PE that they cannot remove or have PE kit on, on days that they do not have PE, they will be in the reflection room instead of in lessons.
- If students **do not wear PE kit on your PE day, they will have a 40 minute** correction.
