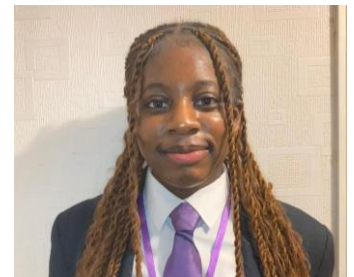



What is Saturday Science?

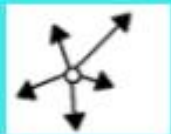
- Remote 2 hour revision session on MS Teams on a Saturday morning (9-11am) run by an amazing Oasis science teacher.
