RE: YEAR 10 AND 11 POST 16 EDUCATION EVENT THURSDAY 14 OCTOBER 5.30-6.30PM

As your child progresses through their GCSE courses, they will be starting to consider their plans for their studies after they finish at Oasis Silvertown. As I am sure you are aware once they leave OAS they are required by law to continue their studies. This may be through the study of academic or vocational courses or by completing an apprenticeship. Additionally if they do not get a minimum of a grade 4 in their English Language and Mathematics GCSEs they are required to continue to study these Post-16.

In order to help your child to prepare for the next stage of their studies, on Thursday 14 October we will be hosting a virtual Post-16 event. The event will run from 5.30pm until 6.30pm. You and your son/daughter are invited to attend via Microsoft Teams to help your child make choices about their future. This event is essential for all students. Your child will be eventually applying to Post 16 providers across Newham and London prior to their final GCSE examinations and the academy will support you and your child throughout this process.

You will receive a link to the event on Wednesday 13 October. During the event you will hear from our Acting Principal, Emily Boxer, our Alumni students from previous Academic years and from Mr James Gordon about course types and providers on offer in Newham and London.

Students will have further opportunities to meet staff from schools, colleges and apprenticeship providers.
